



# Correcting Medications on a Plan of Care Quick Reference Guide

## Introduction

The **Correct Med** function is available in the **Correct** screen in the Plan of Care **Order History** for a Plan of Care order (485 or POT) or for an Interim ROC order. It is not available for Interim Orders. The **Correct Med** function will be disabled once a Plan of Care order has been reviewed for that certification period.

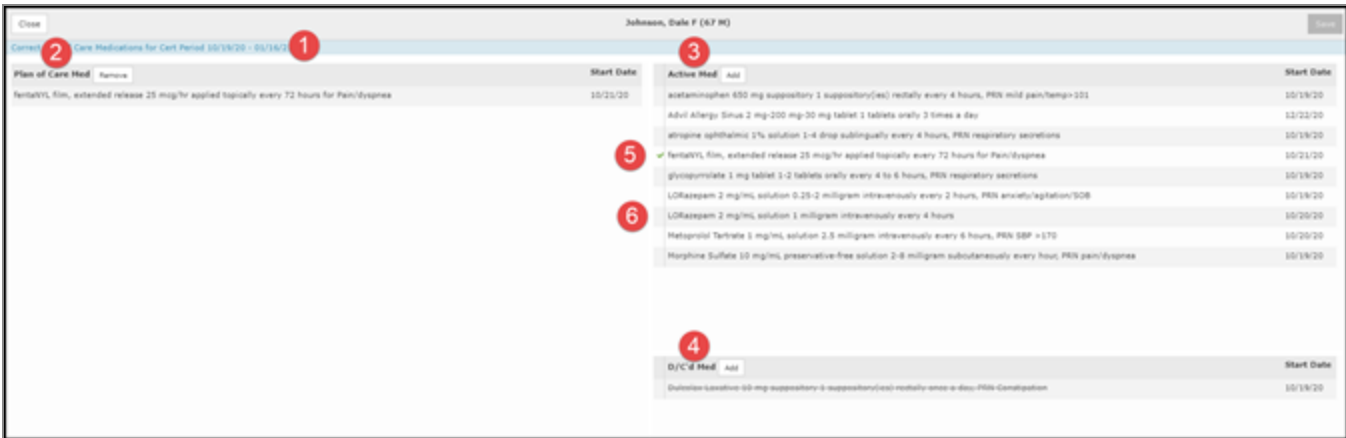
The **Correct Med** function allows for medications that were signed as Interim orders to be added to the Plan of Care medication list. It also allows for medications that have been discharged to be added to the Plan of Care medication list. Medications can also be removed from the Plan of Care medication list, if needed.





Adding or removing medications on the correct screen does not affect the patient’s active chart; it only affects the information displayed on the Plan of Care.

# Understanding the Display



1	Certification Period
2	<b>Plan of Care Med</b> list shows all medications currently included in the Plan of Care Orders.
3	<b>Active Med</b> list shows all medications on the patient's current active med list that have been signed in the selected certification period.
4	<p><b>DC'd Med</b> list shows all discharged medications that have been signed in the selected certification period.</p> <p>D/C'd medications that are also included on the Plan of Care Med list have a green check mark to their left.</p> <p>D/C'd medications that don't have the green check mark have been included in a Interim Order and have the option to be added to the Plan of Care Med list by selecting the <b>Add</b> button.</p>
5	Medications that are also included on the <b>Plan of Care Med</b> list have a green check mark to their left.
6	Medications that don't have a green check mark to their left have been included in an Interim Order and have the option to be added to the <b>Plan of Care Med</b> list by selecting the <b>Add</b> button at the top of the list.

# Add Medications to the Plan of Care Med List

To select an **Active** or **D/C'd** medication to move to the Plan of Care Med list, select the medication(s). Only the medications without a green checkmark next to them can be added.

If there are multiple medications to be added, more than one can be highlighted. Select the medication(s) and then click **Add**.

The medications are added to the **Plan of Care Med** list.

Select **Save** to save these changes.

# Remove Medications from the Plan of Care Med List

If a medication needs to be removed from the **Plan of Care Med** list, highlight it and then select **Remove**. Select **Save**. The medication that was removed is no longer included on the Plan of Care.



Removing a medication from the Plan of Care does not create an Interim Order.

# Interim ROC Order Medication Changes

If an Interim ROC order is being reviewed, the same options as above display.



Interim ROC orders are available if the Plan of Care Agency Configuration in the My Admin Console '**Ability to create ROC Orders**' is set to Yes.

After selecting **Correct** for an Interim ROC order, **Correct ROC Med** is available.
